



Applicants with Baccalaureate Degrees

- If you have earned a baccalaureate degree before enrolling in the RT major courses, then you have the option of completing the Post-BS Certificate of Study in Respiratory Therapy or earning a second baccalaureate degree. The difference between the options is the OSU General Education Curriculum (GEC).
- Post-BS Certificate of Study in Respiratory Therapy students complete all program prerequisites and major requirements. See Curricular Academic Program for Post-BS Certificate in Respiratory Therapy below for details.
- Second degree students must also complete the OSU [General Education Curriculum](#) (GEC). Students with baccalaureate degrees from OSU who have completed the GEC always choose the second baccalaureate degree option.
