RT Applications and Instructions

- Students do NOT need to complete the prerequisites at the time of application, but they should include their plan to complete all prerequisite courses on the Course Schedule Sheet of the on-line application. The RT Admissions Committee uses this plan to determine when applicants will complete the prerequisite courses and be eligible to start courses in the RT major. Some students may be admitted early, one to two years before they schedule courses in the major.
