

**DROP A GEC PETITION FORM**

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Students admitted to an undergraduate professional program in the School of Allied Medical Professions may drop (waive) one General Education Curriculum (GEC) course requirement. This policies applies to students under the “old” GEC requirements (Students who were freshman Spring 2007 and prior, and transfer students who entered Ohio State between Summer 2007-Spring 2008 with 45 or more credit hours).

The GEC categories in which courses **cannot** be dropped include:

- Natural Sciences
- Literature
- Visual/Performing Arts
- Any GEC course specifically required as a prerequisite for admission or program requirement
- Any GEC course already completed to fulfill a GEC requirement (not retroactive)
- Focus requirements. Western, non-U.S. (◆) or non-western /global (★) courses

Submit completed petition form to the Office of Student Affairs, 127 Atwell Hall. Approved petitions will be processed and appropriate exceptions will be posted to the Degree Audit Report.
