MINOR PROGRAM POLICIES AND FORM

University approved minor programs are available to undergraduate students enrolled in SAMP as an option to complement or enhance the major program of study. Minor programs are not required for graduation in SAMP. Minors which have been approved by the University can be accessed online at www.artsandsciences.osu.edu.

1. A minor may not be completed in the same division/program or department as the major.
2. Only one course specified on the major that is also part of an established minor (overlapping courses) may be counted toward both the major and the minor.
3. No grade below a C- will be permitted on courses comprising the minor.
4. Courses taken on a pass/non-pass basis may not be applied toward the minor.
